

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE HAYES STREET BETWEEN FULLER ROAD AND WOOD STREET, AND THE ALLEY BETWEEN FULLER ROAD AND WOOD STREET, AND THE ALLEY BETWEEN STATE STREET AND WAYNE STREET, AND THE ALLEY BETWEEN WAYNE STREET AND WOOD STREET

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause shown for the vacation of Hayes Street between Fuller Road and Wood Street, and the alley between Fuller Road and Wood Street, and the alley between State Street and Wayne Street, and the alley between Wayne Street and Wood Street, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Hayes Street and three alleys in that area, described as follows, be and the same hereby is vacated:

Situated in the City of Elyria, County of Lorain, State of Ohio and being part of Section 4 Carlisle Township and as recorded in Lindale Allotment, Volume 6, Page 42 of the Lorain County Record of Plats.

Hayes Street, fifty feet in width, from the southerly right-of-way line of Fuller Road south to the northerly right-of-way line of State Street; also Hayes Street, fifty feet in width, from the southerly right-of-way line of State Street south to the northerly right-of-way line of Wayne Street; also Hayes Street, fifty feet in width, from the southerly right-of-way line of Wayne Street south to the northerly right-of-way of Wood Street.

Alley, twelve feet in width adjacent to the easterly lot line of a tier of lots facing Middle Avenue, from the southerly right-of-way line of Fuller Road south to the northerly right-of-way line of State Street; also Alley, twelve feet in width adjacent to the easterly lot lines of a tier of lots facing Middle Avenue, from the southerly right-of-way line of State Street south to the northerly right-of-way of Wayne Street; also Alley twelve feet in width adjacent to the easterly lot lines of a tier of lots facing Middle Avenue, from the southerly right-of-way line of Wayne Street south to the northerly right-of-way line of Wood Street.

Alley, twelve feet in width half way between State Street and Wayne Street, from the westerly right-of-way line of Hayes Street westerly a distance of 500 feet, also from the easterly right-of-way line of Hayes Street easterly to the westerly right-of-way line of Edwards Street.

Alley, ten feet in width between Wayne Street and Wood Street, from the westerly right-of-way line of Hayes Street westerly a distance of 500 feet, also from the easterly right-of-way line of Hayes Street easterly to the westerly right-of-way line of Edwards Street.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said Hayes Street and said three alleys, as they are now established, shall forever remain, notwithstanding the passage of this Ordinance, subject to the rights of sanitary sewers and utilities now maintaining their structures, fixtures, and appurtenances in, under, over or upon said lands, to continue to maintain such

This Ord does not specify what properties get their share of the vacated St or Alleys

structures, fixtures and appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing, patrolling and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appurtenances.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
