WHEREAS, a letter of request dated April 11, 1961 from the Elyria Township Trustees was submitted and reads as follows:

"The Trustees have received a request from Frank Yehess, the developer of Debra Drive Allotment in Elyria Township, that Debra Drive be accepted into the Township highway system.

The Trustees recommend the acceptance of this highway as a part of the Township system. All recommendations of the County Engineering Department and the Township Trustees have been complied with.

The Trustees are agreeable to accepting this highway for Township Maintenance."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that we do and hereby accept for maintenance and repair as a Township Road, Debra Drive in Yhess Subdivision, to be maintained by the Elyria Township Trustees.
