

ORDINANCE NO. 61-71

AN ORDINANCE VACATING MARSHALL AVENUE EXTENDING FROM WEST 23RD STREET TO THE ALLEY NORTH OF WEST 23RD STREET IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO.

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of March, 1971, a petition signed by all the owners of property abutting on Marshall Avenue extending from West 23rd Street to the alley north of West 23rd Street, was duly presented to Council, praying that said street be vacated, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.06, notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition is not required, and

WHEREAS, Council upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Marshall Avenue extending from West 23rd Street to the alley north of West 23rd Street, in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be the same hereby is vacated, subject, however, to the reservation that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, electric conduits, telephone and electric pole lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said street whenever deemed necessary by the City of Lorain, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the width of said street shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said street.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
