ORDINANCE NO. 62-79

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE SIDEWALK BETWEEN
WELLER ROAD AND FURNACE STREET

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause shown for the vacation of the sidewalk between Weller Road and Furnace Street, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the following described sidewalk in the City of Elyria be and the same hereby is vacated: Sidewalk between Weller Road and Furnace Street.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said sidewalk, as it is now established, shall forever remain, notwithstanding the passage of this Ordinance, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining their structures, fixtures and appurtenances in, under, over or upon said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures and appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing, patrolling and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appurtenances.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
