

RESOLUTION NO. 63-160

In the matter of granting the petition presented by Marco Gagliotti, Agent, requesting annexation of certain lands now in Amherst Township to the City of Lorain.

March 8, 1963

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, proceeded this day to hear the petition filed by Marco Gagliotti, who was named as Agent to act for the petitioners, and said petition contains a full description of the territory sought to be annexed, and having in open meeting heard all the persons desiring to be heard for or against the granting of said petition and considered the affidavits presented with reference thereto, and being fully advised, finds that said petition contains all the matters required by law; that its statements are true, that the territory sought to be annexed is adjacent to the City of Lorain, Ohio, that the petition is accurate, that said petition is signed by a majority of the adult freeholders residing in the territory sought to be annexed; that the required legal notice of the petition has been given; that an affidavit certifying signatures has been filed, and that it is right and proper that said petition should be granted; and

WHEREAS, At 10:15 A.M., Frank Janik, Mayor of Amherst, telephoned and objected to this annexation saying that this territory should be annexed to Amherst City, since it is included in the area sought to be annexed to Amherst City by Pat Gavlik. The hearings on that petition being scheduled for hearing on April 24, 1963;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that the prayer of said petition be granted and that the territory, described in said petition being part of Original Lot No. 1, 99 and 100, in Amherst Township, more particularly described in the petition, may be annexed to the City of Lorain in accordance with law, and that a certified transcript signed by a majority of this Board of all orders and proceedings held relative to said petition and hearing thereon, together with said petition and map attached thereto, and all papers on file relating to said matter be deposited at once with the Auditor of the City of Lorain, Ohio.

The foregoing resolution was introduced upon a motion by Commissioner J. Norman Thompson, seconded by Commissioner L. M. Pineura and the vote taken thereon resulted as follows: J. Norman Thompson, "aye"; L. M. Pineura, "aye"; James P. Horn, "aye".

Motion carried.


