An Ordinance vacating a portion of an alley between Indiana Avenue and Illinois Avenue.

WHEREAS, on the 5th day of February, 1951, a Petition by persons owning lots in the immediate vicinity of a portion of an alley between Indiana Avenue and Illinois Avenue extending from the south line of Lots Nos. 172 and 152 of Fairhome Addition to an alley north of "F" Street, a distance of about 240 feet, was duly presented to Council praying that the said alley between the points named be vacated, and,

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that said Petition contained 100% of the signatures of the abutting property owners, and that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1.

That the alley between Indiana Avenue and Illinois Avenue, extending from the south line of Lots Nos. 172 and 152 of Fairhome Addition to an alley north of "F" Street, a distance of 240 feet be and the same hereby is vacated with the provision and exception that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, electrical conduits, telephone and electric pole lines and other similar facilities under, on, or above the said alley whenever deemed necessary by the City of Lorain, Ohio.

Section 2.

That the City Auditor is hereby directed to record the vacation of this alley with the Lorain County Auditor and the Lorain County Recorder's Office in Elyria, Ohio.

Section 3.

That this Ordinance shall be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
