

ORDINANCE NO. 66-197

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PURCHASE  
AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS OF THE CITY FROM SIDWELL  
STUDIOS, INC., AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$2,533.10,  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA,  
STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor be and he hereby is  
authorized to enter into a contract with Sidwell Studios, Inc.,  
for the purchase of a set of aerial photographs of the City of  
Elyria according to its proposal of June 29, 1966, at a cost not  
to exceed \$2,533.10.

SECTION 2: That the expenditure referred to in Section  
1 above shall be paid as follows: \$1,266.55 from the Water Works  
Fund, and \$1,266.55 from the Sewer Rental Fund of the City.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is and is hereby  
declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the  
immediate necessity to provide for the public health, peace and  
welfare of the people of the City of Elyria by providing for the  
purchase of a set of aerial photographs of the City; wherefore,  
this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and imme-  
diately after its passage and approval.


