AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF MIDWAY MALL BOULEVARD TO MIDWAY BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause shown for the change in the name of Midway Mail Boulevard to Midway Boulevard, and that such change in name will not be detrimental to the general interest and should be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BLYRIA, STREE OF ORIO:

SECTION 1: That the name of Midway Mail Boulevard extending from State Route 57 to its terminus at West River Street, be and the same hereby is changed to Midway Boulevard.

SECTION 2: This action is taken by the Council on its own motion pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 906, Codified Ordinances of the City of Elyria, Ohio.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
