

An Ordinance to vacate portions of E. 30th Street, Eagle Avenue and other streets within the City of Lorain which are hereinafter more particularly described.

WHEREAS, Council on March 16, 1953 received a 100% petition requesting the vacation of the streets described in section 1 hereof and,

WHEREAS, Council is satisfied there is good cause for said vacation and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and that it ought to be made, subject however, to certain easement and utility control reservations herein set forth,

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Lorain, State of Ohio,

SECTION 1. That the following described streets within the Eulton Division of Lorain, Ohio, to wit:
(1) the portion of E. 30th Street lying westerly of the west line of Victory Avenue extended northerly,
(2) the portions of Eagle Avenue lying northerly of the north line of Lot No. 61 of Eulton Division extended westerly and
(3) the unnamed streets connecting the westerly end of said E. 30th Street and northerly end of said Eagle Avenue,
be and the same are hereby vacated, subject however, to the following reservation and conditions:-

- (1) that the main storm sewer in said section of E. 30th Street remain a public sewer and the City of Lorain, Ohio, hereby reserves easement rights for ingress and egress over said land for the purpose of repair and maintenance of said sewer.
- (2) that all other public sewers and water lines in said portions of streets hereby vacated shall become private sewers and water lines, to be maintained or abandoned as the property owner desires but subject to the same City controls as applies to all other private sewers and water lines.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
