RESOLUTION NO. 68-1009

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that we do and hereby journalize the following Journal Entry from the Department of Highways:

"The following entry was made on the Journal of the Director of Highways, Volume 53 Page 1155, November 22, 1968.

Lorain County - State Route No. 254 - Abandon-ment Granted - Effective November 29, 1968.

Pursuant to Chapter 5511 of the Revised Code of Ohio, the Directors of Highways, of Ohio, on July 24, 1961, approved a relocation of a portion of State Route 254, hearing having been held in Amherst, Ohio, on July 11, 1961. This was recorded on Page 803, Volume 46, of the Journal of the Director of Highways. Said approval stated that the abandonment of the old highway would not be effective until the improvement of the new location was accepted and proper entry made in the Journal of the Director of Highways.

In view of the fact that the improvement of the above mentioned relcation has been accepted, Director Masheter orders that the abandonment referred to in the above mentioned Journal Entry and described below be effective as of November 29, 1968, and that said former location hereby reverts, in part, to the Lorain County Highway System, and, in part, to the Cities of Amherst and Lorain Street System.

ABANDONMENT:

Beginning at a point in the center line of existing State Route 254, (North Ridge Road) where it is intersected by the centerline of State Route 58; thence in an easterly direction along the centerline of existing State Route 254, 4.69 miles, more or less, to its intersection with State Route 57 and there terminate.
