

ORDINANCE NO. 68-120

AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE STREET RUNNING FROM MIDWAY BOULEVARD SOUTH TO ITS SOUTHERLY TERMINUS, "TRAVELERS LANE"

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause shown for the naming of the street running from Midway Boulevard south to its southerly terminus, "Travelers Lane", and that such naming of said street will not be detrimental to the general interest and should be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the street running from Midway Boulevard south to its southerly terminus, be and the same hereby is named "Travelers Lane".

SECTION 2: This action is taken by the Council on its own motion pursuant to the provisions of the general powers of Council, Section 3.08, Charter of the City of Elyria.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk of this Council be and he hereby is directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Lorain County Auditor.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
