

RESOLUTION NO. 68-156

In the matter of naming policies with)
regard to filing annexation petitions.) February 26, 1968

WHEREAS, amended substitute Senate Bill #22 became effective December 1, 1967; and

WHEREAS, this bill is relative to annexation of unincorporated territory to a municipal corporation, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that we do and hereby establish specific policies with respect to the filing of annexations with this Board which are as follows:

- a. That a map of the area, shall be signed by a registered surveyor or engineer.
- b. Whenever roads are involved, the entire thoroughfare must be incorporated in the petition.
- c. That within ten (10) days following the twenty (20) day withdrawal period, the maps will be reviewed by the County Engineer as to their accuracy. The above policy shall become effective February 26, 1968.

The foregoing resolution was introduced upon a motion by Commissioner J. Norman Thompson, seconded by Commissioner J.J. Keron, and the vote taken thereon resulted as follows: J. Norman Thompson, "aye"; J.J. Keron, "aye"; L.M. Pincura, "aye".

Motion carried.
