

ORDINANCE NO. 68-69

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DEED OF THE EXTENSION
EASTERLY OF 13th STREET TO THE CITY FOR STREET
PURPOSES

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Elyria, State
of Ohio:


SECTION 1. That the Deed from ROBERT-DEAN, INC. to the
CITY OF ELYRIA conveying the following described real property
for street purposes be and the same is hereby accepted:


Situated in the City of Elyria, County of
Lorain, State of Ohio and known as being a
part of Original Elyria Township Lot No. 6
between the branches of Black River and
bounded and described as follows:
Beginning at the intersection of the South-
erly line of 13th Street with the Northeast-
erly corner of Sublot No. 23 in Faxons Sub-
division as shown by the recorded plat in
Volume 6 of Maps, Page 7 of Lorain County
Records; thence Easterly along the Southerly
line of 13th Street, now vacated 103 feet;
thence Northerly at right angles thereto
about 50 feet to the Northerly line of 13th
Street now vacated; thence Westerly along the
Northerly line of 13th Street now vacated
about 103 feet to the Southeasterly corner of
Sublot No. 11 in said Faxons Subdivision; thence
Southerly about 50 feet to the place of beginning,
be the same more or less, but subject to all legal
highways.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
