ORDINANCE NO. 69-13

AN ORDINANCE VACATING FORTY-NINTH STREET BETWEEN TILLOTSON AND MORAN STREETS IN LEONA HEIGHTS ALLOTMENT

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause shown for the vacation of Forty-Ninth Street between Tillotson and Moran Streets in Leona Heights Allotment;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the following described portion of Forty-Ninth Street between Tillotson and Moran Streets in Leona Heights Allotment, be and the same hereby is vacated:

Situated in the City of Elyria, County of Lorain and State of Ohio and being part of Original Elyria Township Loc 31, West of Black River and also part of Leona Heights Allotment as recorded in Lorain County Record of Plats Volume 6, Pages 35 and 36 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the North right-of-way line of Forty-Ninth Street (50 feet in width) at the Southeast corner of Sublot 522 of said Leona Heights Allotment; thence East in the North right-of-way line of Forty-Ninth Street a distance of 700 feet to the West right-of-way line of Moran Street; thence South a distance of 50 feet across Forty-Ninth Street to the South right-of-way line of Forty-Ninth Street; thence West in the South right-of-way line of Forty-Ninth Street a distance of 700 feet to the Northeast corner of Sublot 521 in said Leona Heights Allotment; thence North a distance of 50 feet across Forty-Ninth Street to the place of beginning. Containing within said bounds 0.8035 acres of land more or less.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said portion of Forty-Ninth Street between Tillotson and Moran Streets in Leona Heights Allotment, as it is now established shall remain, notwithstanding the passage of this Ordinance, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining their structures, fixtures, and appurtenances in, under, over or upon said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures and appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing, patrolling and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appurtenances.

SECTION 3: That land within the portion of Forty-Ninth Street be equally distributed to abutting property owners in said Leona Heights Allotment.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 68-2

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF SUGAR RIDGE ROAD  
WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA TO ~~BROAD~~  
STREET

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause shown for the change in the name of Sugar Ridge Road within the limits of the City of Elyria to Broad Street, and that such change in name will not be detrimental to the general interest and should be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the name of Sugar Ridge Road extending from Abbe Road easterly to the west corporation line of the City of North Ridgeville, also being the present corporation line of the City of Elyria, be and the same hereby is changed to <sup>East</sup> Broad Street.

SECTION 2: This action is taken by the Council on its own motion pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 906, Codified Ordinances of the City of Elyria, Ohio.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


