ORDINANCE NO. 69-146

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE LACE AVENUE (50 FEET IN WIDTH) BETWEEN THE WEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF BOSTON AVENUE, WESTERLY TO THE EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF CONCORD AVENUE, AND BETWEEN THE WEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF CONCORD AVENUE, WESTERLY TO THE EAST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF LEXINGTON AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

HEREBY OBTAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Lace Avenue (50 feet in width) between the West right-of-way line of Boston Avenue, Westerly to the East right-of-way line of Concord Avenue, and between the West right-of-way line of Concord Avenue, Westerly to the East right-of-way line of Lexington Avenue, and the same hereby is vacated.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said alley, as it is now established, shall remain, notwithstanding the passage of this Ordinance, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining their structures, fixtures, and appurtenances in, under, over or upon said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures and appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing, patching and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appurtenances.

SECTION 3: That Ralph C. and K. M. Lake; Ada S. Fenwick; Dan H. Rice and Secretary of Housing & Urban Development are the sole owners of the adjacent and contiguous property about the area to be vacated.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the City of Elyria by providing for the vacating of a portion of an avenue of the City; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval.
