AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE AN ALLEY RUNNING NORTH OFF
MIDWAY BOULEVARD TO THE FORTY-NINTH STREET OVERPASS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE
OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the following described portion of land,
running North off Midway Boulevard to the Forty-Ninth Street Overpass,
be and the same hereby is vacated:

Situated in the City of Elyria, County of Lorain and
State of Ohio, and being part of Original Elyria Township 31,
West of Black River, and being part of a 10 foot alley in Leona
Heights Allotment as recorded in Lorain County Record of Plats,
Volume 6, Pages 35 and 36, and more particularly described
as follows:

Beginning in the North right-of-way line of Midway Boulevard
(formerly 50th Street) at the Southeast corner of Sublot 432 of
said Leona Heights Allotment; thence North in the East line of
Sublot 432, 433 and 434 a distance of 113.04 feet to a point;
thence East a distance of 10 feet to the West line of Sublot 480;
thence South in the West line of Sublot 480 a distance of 113.07
feet to the North right-of-way line of Midway Boulevard; thence
West in the North right-of-way line of Midway Boulevard a distance
of 10 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.026 acres of land
more or less.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said alley,
as it is now established, shall remain, notwithstanding the passage of
this Ordinance, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining
their structures, fixtures, and appurtenances in, under, over or upon
said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures and
appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary
to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing,
patrolling and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appurtenances.

SECTION 3: That the Lorain County Savings & Trust Company is
the sole owner of the adjacent and contiguous property about the area
to be vacated.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to
provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the
City of Elyria by providing for the vacating of an alley; wherefore,
this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately
after its passage and approval.
