ORDINANCE NO. 70-93

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF MARLBORO ROAD TO NORMANDY DRIVE IN OAKHILL FARMS SUBDIVISION NUMBER TWO IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the name of Marlboro Road in Oakhill Farms Subdivision No. 2, extending from the centerline of Longbrook Road westerly approximately 183.68 feet to the westline of Oakhill Farms Subdivision No. 2 be changed and that the name of Normandy Drive be assigned to said street, upon the passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency, the emergency being the immediate need to change street names within the City, so as to avoid confusion, all for the health, safety and welfare of the City. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor providing it meets the statutory requirement for passage, otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
