WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 71-941 adopted November 11, 1971 the Board of Commissioners set this day for the hearing on proposed vacation proceeding requested by Leroy Forthofer of certain properties in Carlisle Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board did view the site of the requested vacation on December 2, 1971; and

WHEREAS, interested persons in attendance were Edmund J. Witbeck and Ted E. Robson, Carlisle Township Trustees along with Attorney G. L. Severs, representing the petitioner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that we do and hereby grant the vacating of Briarwood Drive in Carlisle Township for which the description reads as follows:

"Beginning on the northerly line of Briarwood Drive at a point 70.0 feet easterly from the south-westerly corner of sublot No. 1 of Ridgewood Subdivision No. 2 as shown by Plat Volume 18, Page 8 of Lorain County Plat Records;

Thence Easterly along the northerly line of Briarwood Drive about 1260 feet to the Northerly line of an easement granted to the State of Ohio for highway purposes by instrument dated August 8, 1956 and recorded in volume 682, Page 178 of Lorain County Deed Records;

Thence South 69°13'32" West along the northerly line of said highway easement and the northerly line of a proposed highway known as Lorain 20/10 - 8.21/8/63 parcel 145WL a distance of about 370 feet to the southerly line of Briarwood Drive as aforesaid;

Thence Westerly along the southerly line of Briarwood Drive about 910 feet to a point 70.0 feet east of the northwesterly corner of Sublot 39 of said Ridgewood Subdivision No. 2;

Thence northerly about 61.5 feet to the place of beginning and containing within said bounds about 1.50 acres of land, be the same more or less, but subject to all legal highways.

Said proposed road outlined on Plat for Ridgewood Subdivision No. 2 is hereby to revert into acreage in its entirety, which operty is owned by Forthofer & Sons, Inc.
