UNDIMENTE NO. 12-201

AN ORDINANCE TO VACAME A THEORE FOOT (12') ALLEY BETWEEN FULLER ROAD AND STANE STREET, AND DECLARING AN ENERGENCY

BE IT ORDATED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YAVRIA, STATE OF CHIO:

SECTION 1: That the twelve foot (12') alley between Fuller Road and State Street, described as follows:

Alley, twolve feet in width halfway between Faller Road and State Street, from the Resterly right-of-way line of Mayes Street Westerly a distance of 500 feet, also from the Easterly right-of-way line from Mayes Street Resterly to the Westerly right-of-way line of Banards Street;

be and the some hereby is vasated.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said twolve foot (12') alley as they are now established, shall remain, notwithstending the passage of this Ordinance, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining their structure, fixtures, and appartmentes in, under, over or upon said lands, to continue to unintain each structures, fixtures and appartenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing, patuolikus and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appartenances.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public health, passe and welfare of the people of the City of Elymia by providing for the vocation of the twelve foot (12") alley between Puller Road and State Street; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approvel.
