AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A TWELVE FOOT (12') ALLEY BETWEEN FULLER ROAD AND STATE STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the twelve foot (12') alley between Fuller Road and State Street, described as follows:

Alley, twelve feet in width halfway between Fuller Road and State Street, from the Western right-of-way line of Hayes Street Western a distance of 500 feet, also from the Eastern right-of-way line from Hayes Street Eastern to the Western right-of-way line of Edwards Street;

be and the same hereby is vacated.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said twelve foot (12') alley as they are now established, shall remain, notwithstanding the passage of this Ordinance, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining their structure, fixtures, and appurtenances in, under, over or upon said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures and appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing, patrolling and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appurtenances.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the City of Elyria by providing for the vacation of the twelve foot (12') alley between Fuller Road and State Street; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval.
