AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE EXTENSION OF LONGOOD AVENUE, SOUTH OF STANFORD AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF ELIZIA, OLDO, AND DESTABLING AN EXERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a potition of all the persons owning land abutting the Southerly extension of Longson Avenue, South of Stanford Avenue, within the City of Eyria, Ohio, was duly presented to Council, praying that said streets be vacated, and written consent to the vacation of said streets has been given by the sole abutting property owner; and

VHEREAS, this matter has been presented to the City Planning Commission and has been approved by the City Planning Commission of the City of Elyria; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Elyria, Ohio, upon consideration, is satisfied that there is just cause for such vacation and that it will not be detrimental to the general interests of the municipality and ought to be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the following described street be and the same hereby is hereby vacated:

Longson Avenue, South of Stanford Avenue

Situated in the City of Elyria, County of Lorain, and State of Ohio, and known as being part of Original Lot No. 6, East of Black River in Elyria Township, commencing at the Northeast corner of Sublot No. 247 as shown on the plat in Lorain County Map Volume 9, Page 32 of Lorain County Records, and known as being Overland Gardens Allotment:

Thence Southerly along the Easterly line of said Sublot No. 247 to the Southeast corner thereof and the Southerly line of said Overland Gardens Allotment;

Thence Easterly along the Southerly line of said Overland Gardens Allotment to the Southeet corner of Sublot No. 248 in said Overland Gardens Allotment;

Thence Northerly along the Westerly line of Sublot No. 243 to the Northwest corner of said Sublot No. 246, which point is in the Southerly line of Stanford Avenue; Thence Westerly in the Southerly line of Stanford

Avenue to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public peace, health and welfare of the people of the City of Elyria, by providing
