

RESOLUTION NO. 73-1078

In the matter of granting the petition for)
vacating an alley in Liberty Subdivision) November 8, 1973
Sheffield Township, Lorain County, Ohio.)

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 73-943-A, this is the day
fixed for the hearing on a petition to vacate an alley in
Liberty Subdivision, Sheffield Township located between Bond
Avenue and Farr Avenue in Original Lot 75; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners did on date of
November 1, 1973 viewed the area to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the proposed notification was
given pursuant to 5553.05 O.R.C.; and

WHEREAS, it was deemed in the best interest of the
public welfare to have said alley vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of
Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio that we do and hereby grant
the vacation of said alley as described below:

Alley #1

Located between Bond Avenue and Farr Avenue,
the distance of the alley is 331.71' starting
at the south line of Wilson Street to the
north line of the alley. Width of said alley
16 feet.

Alley #2

A distance of 228.94' starting at the west line of
Farr Avenue to the east line of Bond Avenue. Width
of said alley 16 feet .

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that said alley being 16 feet
wide shall accrue proportionately 8 feet each side to the
abutting property owners in the vacated area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any permanent easements
to public utilities within this area of the alleys to be vacated
will be maintained pursuant to Section 5553.043.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk is directed to
notify the County Engineer's Department - Tax Map Department;
Lorain County Auditor and Lorain County Recorder on the granting
of this alley vacation proceedings.
