

RESOLUTION NO. 73-550

In the matter of granting the petition)
for vacating an alley in Liberty Subdivision) June 14, 1973
Sheffield Township.)

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 73-470 dated May 7, 1973 the Board of County Commissioners set this date for hearing on a petition to vacate an alley in Liberty Subdivision in Sheffield Township; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the same abovementioned resolution the Board of Commissioners viewed the proposed area to be vacated on June 7, 1973; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the proposed notification was made pursuant to 5553.05 O.R.C.; and

WHEREAS, it was deemed in the interest of the public welfare to have said alley vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that we do and hereby grant the petition to vacate said alley as described below:

"Alley located between Farr Avenue and Bond Avenue. The alley to be vacated is 630.97 feet in length and 16 feet wide starting at the north line of Wilson Street to the south line of Mayfield Street."

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that said alley being 16 feet wide shall accure proportionately 8 feet each side to the abutting property owners in the vacated area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that permanent easements to public utilities within this vacated alley will be maintained pursuant to Section 5553.043.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk is directed to notify the Engineer Tax Map and the Lorain County Auditor and Recorder of the granted petition on alley vacatıon.

The foregoing resolution was introduced upon a motion by Commissioner J. J. Keron, and the vote taken thereon resulted as follows: J. J. Keron, "aye"; Fred M. Ritenauer, "aye"; L. M. Pincura, "aye".

Motion carried.
