

RESOLUTION NO. 73-659

In the matter of granting the petition to)
vacate a road called Hastings Road in Carlisle)
Township, Lorain County, Ohio)

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 73-549 adopted
June 14, 1973 the Board of County Commissioners set this
date for hearing on a petition to vacate Hastings Road in
Carlisle Township, Lorain County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the same abovementioned
resolution the Board of Commissioners viewed the proposed
area to be vacated on July 5, 1973;

WHEREAS, it appears that the proposed notification
was made pursuant to 5553.05 and O. R. C.; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the best interests
of the public welfare to have said road vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board
of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that we do and hereby
grant the petition to vacate said road as described below:

"Situating in Original Section 19 and 20 of the Town-
ship of Carlisle, County of Lorain, State of Ohio and
bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of Hale Road and Hastings
Road which is also the West line of Section 20 and
the West Line of Carlisle Township; thence South 89°20'
East along the centerline of Hastings Road a distance
of 2629.86 feet to the Northeast corner of land conveyed
to Woodrow W. and Fay Teets by deed volume 415, page
147 of Lorain County Record of Deeds and being the
principal place of beginning; Thence South 89° 20' East
along the centerline of Hastings Road a distance of
about 4894 feet to a point which is 114 chains distance
from Hale Road by Lorain County Record Volume 1, page
271. Being a strip of land 30 feet wide by right
angles on each side of said centerline. Containing
within said bounds about 3.86 acres in Section 20,
2.88 acres in Section 19, for a total of 6.74 acres of
land, be the same, more or less. "

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that said road being 60
feet wide shall accrue to the benefit of Metropolitan Park, and


shall be subject to all established easements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk is directed to notify the Engineer, Tax Map Department, Lorain County Auditor and Recorder on the granting of this petition for the purpose of record.

The foregoing resolution was introduced upon a motion by Commissioner L. M. Pincura, seconded by Commissioner J. J. Keron, and the vote taken thereon resulted as follows: L. M. Pincura, "aye"; J. J. Keron, "aye"; Fred M. Ritenauer, "aye".
