

ORDINANCE NO. 7489

An Ordinance granting to the Lorain-Elyria Sand Company a permit to construct a dock on the easterly side of Black River along the westerly side of Black River and the said company's property.

Whereas, the City of Lorain contemplates the changing of the existing dock line abutting the property of the Lorain-Elyria Sand Company's property along the easterly side of Black River, and

Whereas, circumstances do not permit the changing of said dock line at the present time, due to the City Engineer and Solicitor being presently engaged in preparing a new dock line ordinance on both sides of the Black River, which preparation requires considerable time for the fixing of the existing dock lines, and the subsequent revisions thereto, and for the further reason that it is necessary for said officials to study the various deeds and grants to the City of Lorain of property in and along the Black River, and

Whereas, the Lorain-Elyria Sand Company is desirous of building a dock along the proposed change of dock line fronting their property on the easterly side of Black River, and

Whereas, said company proposes to construct a permanent dock beginning at the northerly boundary of their property along Black River and extending in a southerly direction along the dock line as proposed, a distance of 200 feet, and

Whereas, said company has secured a permit from the federal authorities authorizing the construction of said 200 feet of dock, and

Whereas, a permit from the City of Lorain is desired by said company to construct said dock,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That a permit shall be and hereby is granted to the Lorain-Elyria Sand Company to construct a dock commencing at the northerly line of said company's property along the easterly side of Black River and extending southerly along the dock line as proposed, as evidenced by the plat hereto attached and made a part hereof, a distance of 200 feet.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Lorain, and for the further reason that the immediate granting of such permit is urgently required so as to provide for the effective, proper and orderly development of property along the easterly side of Black River.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage by law.
