AN ORDINANCE CHANGING STREET NAMES IN THE WEST RIVER PARKWAY PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the following changes in street names in the West River Parkway Project shall be made, effective July 1, 1977:

1. Lake Avenue from Lowell Street intersection to West River Street, be changed to Gateway Boulevard.
2. Beech Street be changed to Gateway Boulevard.
3. Vulcan Street be changed to Gateway Boulevard.
4. Relocated Huron Street be named Fremont Street (old section remain Huron).
5. Second Street be extended Westerly to the B & O Railroad tracks.
6. Third Street be extended Westerly to the B & O Railroad tracks.
7. Lodi Street be changed to Lake Avenue from Broad Street to present Lake Avenue.
8. Lorain Boulevard be extended from Lodi Street to West River Road.
9. West River Street, West River Road, South, and West River Road, North, be renamed West River Road.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the City of Elyria by providing for the changing of street names in the West River Parkway Project; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval.
