In the matter of vacating alleys in Liberty) Subdivision of Sheffield Township, Lorain ) County, Ohio.

September 30, 1975

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that we do and hereby determine to vacate the following alleys as described in the petition located in Sheffield Township as provided by Section 5553.04 Revised Code of Ohio:

"We, the undersigned, owners of lots and lands situated in the Liberty Subdivision Vol. 9-816 of Sheffield Township, Lorain County, Ohio, hereby petition the Honorable Board of Trustees of Sheffield Township to vacate the alley described below.

The alley that we, the undersigned wish to have vacated is located in between Liberty & Bond Avenue. The distance of the alley to be vacated is 1140.97' starting at the north line of Wilson Street directly north to Frankfort Street where the alley dead ends. The width of the alley is 16'.

If, the prayer of the petitioners is answered, we the undersigned will grant the right of all public utilities to enter upon the land that we wish to have vacated, also when the alley is vacated each abutting property shall receive eight feet (8).

We each and severally, agree to share the cost of the alley to be vacated.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that the alley is hereby declared vacated as follows: Located in Liberty Subdivision of Sheffield Township, Lorain County, Ohio, between Liberty and Bond Avenues. The distance being 1,140.97 feet starting at the north line of Wilson Street directly north to Frankfort Street. The width of the alley being 16 feet wide and shall be divided equally and accrue proportion—wide and shall be divided equally and accrue proportion—ately to the property owners according to the width of their property as defined on the map attached to the petition and made a part hereof of this journalization.

The foregoing resolution was introduced upon a motion by Commissioner L. M. Pincura, seconded by Commissioner Fred M. Ritenauer, and the vote taken thereon resulted as follows: L. M. Pincura, "aye"; Fred M. Ritenauer, "aye"; J. J. Keron, "aye".
