

ORDINANCE NO. 1533

An Ordinance Vacating Certain Streets and Alleys  
in the Vicinity of W. 23rd and W. 24th Streets.

Whereas, on the 16 day of September, 1957, a petition by owners of lots in the immediate vicinity of West 23rd and West 24th Streets in the Park Plan First Addition to the City of Lorain was duly presented to Council praying as follows:

1. That West 24th Street, from Leavitt Road to the West line of Reeves Avenue, be vacated and the land revert to the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon.
2. That a 16-foot alley lying between West 23rd Street and West 24th Street, from the West lines of Sublots Nos. 93 and 107 to the West line of Reeves Avenue, be vacated and that the land revert to the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon.
3. That Brightman Avenue, from the Northerly limits of the Park Plan First Addition to the City of Lorain to the Southerly line of said Addition, be vacated and the land revert to the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon.
4. That Hartman Avenue, from the South line of West 23rd Street to the Southerly line of the Park Plan First Addition to the City of Lorain, Ohio, be vacated and that the land from the South line of West 23rd Street to a point 109.14 feet South thereof revert to the Duffin Manufacturing Company, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon, and the balance of the land revert to the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon, ~~and notice of the pendency and prayer of the said petition has been given as required by law, by publication in The Lorain Journal, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Lorain, Ohio, for six consecutive weeks, ending \_\_\_\_\_, 195\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_~~

Whereas, Council, ~~upon hearing~~, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That West 24th Street, from Leavitt Road to the West line of Reeves Avenue, be and the same is hereby vacated and the land revert to the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon.
- Section 2. That a 16-foot alley lying between West 23rd Street and West 24th Street, from the West lines of Sublots Nos. 93 and 107 to the West line of Reeves Avenue, be and the same is hereby vacated and the said land revert to the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon.
- Section 3. That Brightman Avenue, from the Northerly limits of the Park Plan First Addition to the City of Lorain to the Southerly line of said Addition, be vacated and the land revert to the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon.

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Section 4.

That Hartman Avenue, from the South line of West 23rd Street to the Southerly line of the Park Plan First Addition to the City of Lorain, Ohio, be and the same is hereby vacated and the land from the South line of West 23rd Street to a point 109.14 feet South thereof revert to the Duffin Manufacturing Company, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon, and the balance of the land revert to the Lorain Metropolitan Housing Authority, they being the owner of 100% of the land abutting thereon.

Section 5.

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
