SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Citizens of Amherst, the emergency being the immediate necessity to advertise said notices in order to meet deadline requirements of the Amherst Hospital Project.

WHEREFORE, THIS RESULUTION SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.
