

RESOLUTION NO. 76-01

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLERK OF COUNCIL TO ADVERTISE FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF PROSPECT STREET, AND NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING SAME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Now, Therefore, be it RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Amherst, County of Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the Clerk of Amherst City Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for six (6) consecutive weeks the pendency of action by Amherst City Council to vacate a portion of Prospect Street, in the City of Amherst, Ohio, at the regularly scheduled meeting of Amherst City Council to be held March ~~8~~^{27th} 1976, at 7:30 PM, City Hall.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk of Amherst City Council is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for six (6) consecutive weeks a Notice of a Public Hearing held by the Amherst City Council Building and Lands Committee concerning the vacation of a portion of Prospect Street in the City of Amherst, Ohio, to be held March 8, 1976, at 7:00 PM, City Hall.

SECTION 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the Citizens of Amherst, the emergency being the immediate necessity to advertise said notices in order to meet deadline requirements of the Amherst Hospital Project.

WHEREFORE, THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.
