

ORDINANCE NO. 78-112

AN ORDINANCE VACATING MALCOLM COURT IN THE MANNER
MANNER URBAN RENEWAL SITE, AND DESIGNING SAID COURT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE
OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Malcolm Court in the Malcolm Court Urban
Renewal site, described as follows, be and the same hereby is

Situated in the City of Elyria, Township of Black River,
Lorain, State of Ohio, and being a part of Original Loc. 56
58 in the East of the Black River Tract, Town of Black River,
also being a part of the former Glover Addition, as shown on
Plat Volume 8, Page 23, as recorded in the Lorain County, Ohio
Plats, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing from a point at the South by & West line of Perry
Street and the West by & West R/W line of Perry Court; thence N 48° 00'
47" W, 22.83 feet to a point; thence S 63° 58' 10" E, 123.83 feet
to the true point of beginning; thence S 20° 34' 50" E, 87.80 feet
to a point; thence S 00° 34' 50" E, 134.50 feet to a point;
thence S 89° 27' 20" W, 40.00 feet to a point; thence S 80°
50" W, 127.20 feet to a point; thence N 20° 34' 50" W, 111.00 feet
to a point in the Southernly R/W line of Cleveland Street; thence
on a curve to the right having a radius of 292.68 feet, and
bearing N 55° 05' 05" E, 40.50 feet + to the described point of
beginning.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said Malcolm
Court, as they are now established, shall remain notwithstanding the
passage of this Ordinance subject to the rights of utilities now
maintaining said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures
and appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably
necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing,
repairing, patrolling and maintaining such structures, fixtures and
appurtenances.

SECTION 3: That Malcolm Court as herein vacated shall revert
to the owners of the adjacent property.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal
actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this
Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all
deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees, that result
in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compli-
ance with all legal requirements, including Section 223.02 of the Ohio Public
Access Act.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to
be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to
provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the
City of Elyria by providing for the vacation of Malcolm Court; wherefore
this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately
after its passage and approval.

ORDINANCE NO. 78-112

AN ORDINANCE VACATING MALCOLM COURT IN THE MALCOLM MANOR URBAN RENEWAL SITE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE

OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Malcolm Court in the Malcolm Manor Urban Renewal site, described as follows, be and the same hereby is vacated:

Situated in the City of Elyria, Township of Elyria, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, and being a part of Original Lots 66, 67 and 68 in the East of the Black River Tract, Town 6-N, Range 17-W, and also being a part of the former Glover Allotment, as recorded in Plat Volume 6, Page 23, as recorded in the Lorain County Record of Plats, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing for a point at the Southerly R/W line of Cleveland Street and the Westerly R/W line of Perry Court; thence N 45° 07' 47" W, 22.83 feet to a point; thence S 69° 55' 10" W, 273.83 feet to the true point of beginning; thence S 20° 34' 50" E, 87.80 feet to a point; thence S 00° 34' 50" E, 134.50 feet to a point; thence S 89° 27' 26" W, 40.00 feet to a point; thence N 00° 34' 50" W, 127.20 feet to a point; thence N 20° 34' 50" W, 78.00 feet to a point in the Southerly R/W line of Cleveland Street; thence on a curve to the right having a radius of 292.08 feet, a chord bearing N 35° 05' 05" E, 40.50 feet + to the described point of beginning.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said Malcolm Court, as they are now established, shall remain notwithstanding the passage of this Ordinance, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures
