ORDINANCE NO. 78 <u>- 233</u>

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CAROL LANE
AND HAWAII COURT LOCATED IN CHESTNUT
RIDGE HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION NO. 3, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.05 of the Ohio Revised Code, when there is a good cause for vacating a street, no petition is required;

WHEREAS, this legislative body required the dedication of rights of way for Carol Lane and Hawaii Court as a part of Chestnut Ridge Heights Subdivision No. 3, and, now the said rights of way are preventing the filing of the plat for Chestnut Ridge Heights Subdivision No. 4;

WHEREAS, written consent of all the owners of the property abutting the streets proposed to be vacated is filed pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 723.06;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Elyria, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the following described dedicated street, also known as Carol Lane be vacated, to wit:

Situated in the City of Elyria, County of Lorain, and State of Ohio, and being known as part of Original Carlisle Township Section 5 and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northerly line of Carol Lane, 60 feet wide, at the southeasterly corner of Sublot 89 in Chestnut Ridge Heights Subdivision No. 3, recorded in Volume 33, Pages 3 and 4 of the Lorain County Plat Records:

Thence South 86⁰ 42' 39" East, along the northerly right-of-way line of Carol Lane, a distance of 160.32 feet to a point of curvature;

Thence in the arc of a curve which deflects to the left, a distance of 30.63 feet to a point of reverse curve; said curve having a radius of 50.00 feet, central angle of 35° 05′ 48″, chord of 30.15 feet which bears North 75° 44′ 27″ East;

Thence in the arc of a curve which deflects to the right, a distance of 278.11 feet to a point of reverse curve; said curve having a radius of 60.00 feet, central angle of 265 34' 32", and a chord of 88.06 feet which bears South 10 58' 49" West;

Thence in the arc of a curve which deflects to the left, a distance of 44.05 feet to a point of tangency; said curve having a radius of 50.00 feet, central angle of 50° 28′ 44″, and a chord of 61° 28′ 17″ West:

Thence North 86° 42' 39" West, along the southerly right-of-way line of Carol Lane, a distance of 138.72 feet to a point at the northeasterly corner of Sublot 100;

Thence North 3⁰ 17' 21" East, a distance of 60.00

feet to the place of beginning;

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Containing within said bounds 0.493 acres to be the same more or less, but subject to all legal highways.

SECTION 2: That the following described dedicated street, also known as Hawaii Court be vacated, to wit:

> Situated in the City of Elyria, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, and being known as part of Original Carlisle Township Section 5 and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northerly right-ofway line of Hawaii Court at the southeasterly corner of Sublot 101 in Chestnut Ridge Heights Subdivision No. 3, recorded in Volume 33, Pages 3 and 4 of the Lorain

County Plat Records; Thence South 86° 42' 39" East, along the northerly right-of-way line of Hawaii Court, a distance of 171.57

feet to a point of curvature;

Thence in the arc of a curve which deflects to the right, a distance of 133.52 feet to a point of tangency; said curve having a radius of 85.00 feet, central angle of 90°00', and a chord of 120.21 feet which bears South 41°42' 39" East;

Thence South 3°17' 21" West, a distance of 16.55

feet to a point of curvature;

Thence in the arc of a curve which deflects to the left, a distance of 37.82 feet to a point of reverse curve; said curve having a radius of 50.00 feet, central angle of 43° 20' 30", and a chord of 36.93 feet which bears South 18° 22' 54" East;

Thence in the arc of a curve which deflects to the right, a distance of 279.27 feet to a point of reverse curve; said curve having a radius of 60.00 feet, central angle of 266° 41' 00", and a chord of 87.27 feet which bears North 86° 42' 39" West;

Thence in the arc of a curve which deflects to the left, a distance of 37.82 feet to a point of tangency; said curve having a radius of 50.00 feet, central angle of 43° 20' 30", and a chord of 36.93 feet which bears North 24° 57' 36" East;

Thence North 3° 17' 21" East, a distance of 16.55

feet to a point of curvature;

Thence in the arc of a curve which deflects to the left, a distance of 39.27 feet to a point of tangency; said curve having a radius of 25.00 feet, central angle of 90°00'00", and a chord of 35.36 feet which bears North 41°42'39" West;

Thence North 86°42'39" West, along the southerly might of way line of Hawaii Court, a distance of 171.57

right-of-way line of Hawaii Court, a distance of 171.57 feet to a point at the northeasterly corner of Sublot

Thence North 30 17' 21" East, a distance of 60.00 feet to the place of beginning; (CONTINUED)

Containing within said bounds 0.666 acres to be the same more or less, but subject to all legal highways.

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SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees, that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the City of Elyria, by providing for the vacation of Carol Lane and Hawaii Court; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval.
