ORDINANCE NO. 81-154

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CEDAR STREET NORTH OF THE CONRAIL BRIDGE THROUGH THE PINE STREET INTERSECTION TO A LINE EXTENDED SOUTHWARD FROM THE WEST WALL OF THE HARSHAW POLLUTION CONTROL CENTER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Cedar Street north of the Conrail Bridge through the Pine Street intersection to a line extended southward from the west wall of the Harshaw Pollution Control Center, be and the same hereby is vacated.

SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said street, as they are now established, shall remain notwithstanding the passage of this Ordinance, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures and appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing, patrolling and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appurtenances.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the City of Elyria by providing for the vacation of Cedar Street north of the Conrail Bridge through the Pine Street intersection to a line extended southward from the west wall of the Harshaw Pollution Control Center; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval.
