WHEREAS, by letter dated September 29, 1982 the Lorain County Engineer advised the Board of Commissioners on the abandonment, by the State, of Butternut Ridge Road and that he had inspected the roadways and found them to be in acceptable and satisfactory condition and recommended the County accept same into the County Highway System; and

WHEREAS, he further advised that as a part of the highway project a service road off Durkee Road approximately 3290 feet in length had been construted and is to be released to the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that we do and hereby accept the following described roads into the County Highway System as abandoned by the State:

Situated in the Township of Eaton, County of Lorain, State of Ohio and being part of Original Eaton Township Lot Nos. 93, 88, 89, 72, 69, 70, 51.

DESCRIPTION No. One.

"Commencing at a point on the centerline of old State Route 10, (Butternut Ridge Road), said point being centerline Station 825 + 60.47. Thence North 30°-52'-58" West a distance of 30.00 feet where it intersects the radius point of 40.00 foot radius cul-de-sac; thence South 59°-07'02" West a distance of 40.00 feet to a point which is the centerline intersection of the centerline of old State Route 10 (Butternut Ridge Road) and at the circumference of said 40 foot radius cul-de-sac, said point being Station 825+20.47 and the place of beginning; thence Northeasterly along the centerline of old State Route 10, (Butternut Ridge Road) to the centerline of Durkee Road, designated as S.L.M. 16.38, and Station 864+03.28; thence continuing Northeasterly along the centerline of old State Route 10 (Butternut Ridge Road) to the centerline of Archer Road, designated as S.L.M. 17.29, and Station 912+16.28, thence continuing Northeasterly along the centerline of old State Route 10 (Butternut Ridge Road) to the centerline of relocated State Route 83 and Station 947+75.28; said point also being Southwesterly 0.10 miles from the intersection of old State Route 10, (Butternut Ridge Road), and the South Corporation line of the city of North Ridgeville, having a total distance of 2,320 miles."

DESCRIPTION No. Two (Service Road) # 15423

Situated in the Township of Eaton, County of Lorain, State of Ohio and being a part of Original Eaton Township Lot No. 89

Beginning at a point at the centerline extension of Durkee Service Road at its intersection with the West line of lands conveyed to Louis P. Christen by Deed Volume 1175, Page 970, Lorain County Record of Deeds; said point is 175 feet left of Station 825+99.73 of U. S. Route 20-15.99, said point also being centerline Durkee service Road Station 25+99.73. Thence Northeasterly along the centerline of Durkee Service Road a distance of 2633.39 feet to the P. C. of a curve with a radius of 200.00 feet; said point is centerline Durkee Service Road Station 52+33.12; thence along the centerline arc of said curve a distance of 194.31 feet to the P. T. of said curve; said point is centerline Durkee

Service Road Station 54+27.43; thence Northeasterly along the centerline of Durkee Service Road a distance of 256.12 feet to the P. C. of a curve with a radius of 100.00 feet; thence along the centerline arc of said curve a distance of 157.08 feet to the P. C. of said curve; thence along the centerline of Durkee Service Road a distance of 50.00 feet to the centerline of Durkee Road, having a total distance of 0.623 miles.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that said service road known as Durkee Road is hereby renamed Pounds Road and assigned the County Road Number 211, effective October 21, 1982.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that the portion of old State Road 10 described in description No. 1 known as Butternut Ridge Road, from State Route 57 easterly to the relocated State Route 83 is hereby designated as a township Road in Eaton Township and that the Service Road renamed Pounds Road also be designated a Township Road in Eaton Township.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that all of the above described roads are to be within jurisdiction of Eaton Township to be maintained by said Township.

An opinion dated October 15, 1982 being Opinion No. 82-109 from the County Prosecutor's Department also referred to Section 5511.01 Revised Code and that the Board of Commissioners accept the above road improvements accordingly.
