In the matter of granting alley vacations located in Lorain Heights Allotment and Liberty Subdivision, Sheffield Township, Lorain County, Ohio.

November 16, 1982

WHEREAS, after due and legal advertising and personal notice this is the day fixed for the public hearing on vacating of two alleys in Sheffield Township, Lorain County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, no objections were filed and expressed to the vacating of these alleys by the residents concerned;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that we do and hereby determine and authorize the vacation of the following described alleys:

- 1. Lorain Heights Allotment Volume 6, Page 21 of Lorain County Plat Records Sheffield Township:
  - Alley located between Grant Street and Lincoln Street and bordered on the west by Oakwood Avenue and on the east by the Heyslinger property being approximately 325.8 feet in length more or less and being 15 feet wide.
- 2. Liberty Subdivisions Volume 9 Page 26 Lorain County Plat records, Sheffield Township:
- 3. Alley located between Fleming Avenue and Liberty Avenue a distance of approximately 1,140.97 feet, more or less, south from Frankford Street to Wilson Street and being 16 feet wide.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that said vacation of the aforesaid alleys shall accrue proportionately to the benefit of the adjacent property owners as provided by law.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the lands within the limits of said alleys as they are now established, shall forever remain, notwithstanding the passage of this resolution, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining structures, fixtures and appurtenances in, under, over or upon said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures and appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing, patrolling and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appurtenances.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the County Recorder, Auditor, Engineer, Tax Map, and Township Trustees for recording and filing.
