WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, fixed the 26th day of April 1983 at 11:00 A.M. for the hearing to consider the proposed name change of Pounds Road to Cletus Drive in Eaton Township; and

WHEREAS, the Engineer of Lorain County at the request of the Board was the only person in attendance at the hearing and voiced no objections to this name change;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, that as provided by Section 5541.04 R.
