AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 81-154,
BY MORE FULLY DESCRIBING THE PROPERTY BEING VACATED, AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Cedar Street north of the Conrail Bridge through the Pine Street intersection to a line extended southward from the west wall of the Harshaw Pollution Control Center, be and the same hereby is vacated, more fully described as follows:

Beginning at a point, said point being at the intersection of the east right-of-way line of Center Street and north right-of-way line of Pine Street, as shown on H.E. Ely's addition to Elyria, recorded in Volume 1, page 35, of the County Recorder's Plat Records, thence eastward 125.40 feet, more or less, along the north line of Pine Street to a point on the original east line of Cedar Street; thence southward 330.00 feet, more or less, along the east line of Cedar Street to a point on the north line of the railroad right-of-way; thence westward crossing the Cedar Street right-of-way to a point on the west right-of-way line of Cedar Street; thence northward 284.20 feet, more or less, to a point on the south right-of-way line of Pine Street; thence westward 59.40 feet, more or less, along the south line of Pine Street to a point; thence northward 66 feet to the point of beginning; with said area so described containing 26,367 square feet or 0.605 acres. (The above description was prepared from available records without a field survey.)

SECTION 2: That all other sections and parts of sections of Ordinance No. 81-154 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the City of Elyria by providing for the amendment of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 81-154, by more fully describing the property being vacated; wherefore, this Ordinance
