## ORDINANCE NO. 84-93

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF A PORTION OF HUNIER'S TRAIL TO DEER RUN AND HUNIER'S COURT TO HUNIER'S TRAIL IN HUNIER'S WOODS SUBDIVISION NO. 1 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the owner of Hunter's Woods Subdivision No. 1 has requested a formal change in the name of a portion of Hunter's Trail to Deer Run and a change in the name of Hunter's Court to Hunter's Trail, to meet the concerns of safety forces and in accord with the recommendation of Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AVON, LORAIN COUNTY, OHIO:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the subdivision plat for Hunter's Woods Subdivision No. 1, recorded at Volume 49, pages 73 and 74 at Lorain County Records shall be amended as follows:

- a. The stub street between the East line of Sublot 13 and the West line of Sublot 12, currently known as Hunter's Trail shall be changed to Deer Run.
- b. The street extending to the West beyond the above-described stub street, currently shown on the plat as Hunter's Court, South of the southerly line of Sublot 13 and North of the northerly line of Sublot 14 and part of the northerly line of Sublot 15 shall be changed to Hunter's Trail.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Avon, the immediate emergency being the need to change the name of certain streets in the sublot prior to approval of further subdivisions and to address concerns of the safety forces; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
