ORDINANCE NO. 85-46

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY ON ELBE STREET, AS SHOWN IN THE L. FAY ADDITION TO ELYRIA LOT 87 ON VOLUME 3, PAGE 43 OF LORAIN COUNTY MAPS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 84-196, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause shown for the vacation of the alley on Elbe Street, as shown in the L. Fay Addition to Elyria Lot 87, on Volume 3, Page 43 of Lorain County Maps, and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the alley east of Elbe Street adjoining Sublots 1 thru the southerly part of 13, as shown in the L. Fay Addition to Elyria, Lot 87, Volume 3, Page 43 of Lorain County Maps, be and the same hereby is vacated.


SECTION 2: That the lands within the limits of said alley, as they are now established, shall remain notwithstanding the passage of this Ordinance, subject to the rights of utilities now maintaining said lands, to continue to maintain such structures, fixtures and appurtenances, and to enter upon said lands whenever reasonably necessary to do so for the purpose of inspecting, altering, replacing, repairing, patrolling and maintaining such structures, fixtures and appurtenances.

SECTION 3: That the alley as herein vacated shall revert to the owners of the adjacent property.

SECTION 4: That Ordinance No. 84-196, adopted by the Council of the City of Elyria on October 15, 1984, be and the same hereby is repealed.

SECTION 5: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 6: That this Ordinance is and is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the City of Elyria by providing for the vacation of the alley on Elbe Street, as shown in the L. Fay
