ORDINANCE NO. 9.06

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY WEST OF BROADWAY AVE. FROM THE SOUTHLINE OF WEST 27TH STREET SOUTHERLY TO THE NORTHLINE OF WEST 28TH STREET.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF UHIO:

SECTION I. This council finds that a petition signed by the owners of all of the

property abutting upon the alley west of Broadway Ave. from the Southline of West 27th Street southerly to the Northline of West 28th Street has been presented to this Council, praying that said alley

between the points be vacated (see attached).

SECTION II. Council further finds that there is good cause for such vacation of

SECTION V. The Clerk of Council is directed to notify the Auditor of Lorain

County of the vacation by sending him a copy of this ordinance.

SECTION VI. All formal actions of Council relating to the adoption of this

ordinance, and all deliberations of Council and any of its committees leading to such action, were in meetings open to the

public as required by law.

SECTION VII. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
