AN ORDINANCE VACATING EAST MILL STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON, CHIO

WHEREAS, it has been determined in the opinion of the Council of the Village of Grafton that there is good cause for vacating a street in the Village known as East Mill Street and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that written consent to such vacation has been filed with the Council by the owners of the property abutting the street to be vacated thereby removing any further notice requirements, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Grafton that said street be vacated, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF GRAFTON, STATE OF DHID:

- <u>Section 1:</u> That the street known as East Mill Street in the Village of Grafton is hereby vacated.
- Section 2: That there was good cause for said vacation, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest of the Village and that written consent to such vacation has been filed by the owners of the property abutting the street thereby removing any further notice requirements.

Section 3:	That the Clerk-Treamurm is hereby directed to notify all proper and necessary parties of the vacation including the forwarding of the plat and/or description attached hereto and incorporated herein showing the public way vacated.
<u>Section 4</u> :	That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including the Ohio Revised Code.
