

ORDINANCE NO. 92-70

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY NORTH OF "E" STREET  
EXTENDING FROM IDAHO AVENUE EASTERLY ABOUT 132 FEET  
TO THE WEST LINE OF THE NORTH, SOUTH ALLEY BETWEEN  
IDAHO AVENUE AND ILLINOIS AVENUE.

WHEREAS, on the 1st day of June, 1970 a petition signed by all the owners of property abutting on the alley north of "E" Street extending from Idaho Avenue easterly about 132 feet to the west line of the north, south alley between Idaho Avenue and Illinois Avenue was duly presented to Council, praying that said alley be vacated, and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.06, notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition is not required, and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: The alley north of "E" Street extending from Idaho Avenue easterly about 132 feet to the west line of the north, south alley between Idaho Avenue and Illinois Avenue in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be and the same hereby is vacated, subject, however, to the reservation that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sewer lines, water lines, gas lines, electric conduits, telephone and electric pole lines and other similar facilities under on or above said alley whenever deemed necessary by the City of Lorain, Ohio.

SECTION 2. That one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the width of said alley shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said alley.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
