AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 709.031 INDICATING WHAT SERVICES THE CITY OF ELYRIA WILL PROVIDE UPON ANNEXATION TO TERRITORY OWNED BY KEITH M. OSKINS, DENISE A. OSKINS, AND HIGHLAND DEVELOPMENT CO., AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Dale Yost, Agent for Petitioner Keith M. Oskins, Denise A. Oskins, and Highland Development Co., has petitioned has petitioned the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, to annex to the City of Elyria certain parcels of land and more fully described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elyria is desirous of having said territory described in Exhibit "A" annexed to the City of Elyria;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 709.031 (A), the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, have set October 6, 1994 at 2:00 p.m. in the Commissioners' Hearing Room, 4th Floor, Lorain County Administration Building, 226 Middle Avenue, Elyria, Ohio, as the time and place for the hearing on the petition of Keith M. Oskins, Denise A. Oskins, and Highland Development Co.

WHEREAS, on August 17, 1994, Jack Lesnick, Clerk of Council of the City of Elyria, received notice of the time and place for the hearing on said Petition; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 709.031 (B) requires that the City of Elyria adopt by ordinance a statement indicating what services the City of Elyria will provide upon annexation to the territory owned by said petitioners, and proposed for annexation to the City of Elyria.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the City of Elyria will provide, upon annexation, to the territory described in Exhibit "A", and owned by Keith M. Oskins, Denise A. Oskins and Highland Development Co., which territory is proposed for annexation to the City of Elyria, Ohio, the following services: police, fire, garbage collection, storm sewer and sanitary sewer, subject to Highland Development Corporation completing the storm sewer, sanitary sewer and water main which is located in East Hampton Subdivision No. 3 and adjacent to the street right of way of the territory to be annexed. Upon said completion, Development Highland Corporation shall transfer the storm sewer, sanitary sewer and water main to the City for public use and maintenance. Said services shall be provided at the rates and fees as established by this Council for such services.

SECTION 2: That a certified copy of this Ordinance shall be delivered to the Board of Commissioners of Lorain County, Ohio, prior to October 6, 1994, by the Clerk of Council.

SECTION 3: It is hereby determined by the Council of the City of Elyria that the territory described in Section 1 above shall be a part of Ward 3 of the City.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance be and hereby is declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the immediate necessity to provide for the public health, peace and welfare of the people of the City of Elyria; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval.

We, the undersigned, being competent adult individuals seized of a freehold estate in the within described territory, and being a majority of the owners of the real estate as hereinafter more fully described, do hereby petition for the annexation of said territory to the City of Elyria, Lorain County, Ohio, to wit;
