ORDINANCE NO. **94-80**

AN ORDINANCE VACATING IDAHO AVENUE (60' WIDE) FROM THE SOUTHLINE OF "G" STREET, 135' SOUTH TO THE SOUTHLINE OF W.B. THOMPSON TR'S ADDITION IN THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of June 1980, a petition signed by 100% of the owners of property abutting Idaho Avenue 60' wide, extending from the south side of "G" Street, 135' to the southline of the W.B. Thompson's Tr's Addition in the City of Lorain, was duly presented to Council praying that said portion of the street be vacated; and

WHEREAS, on the 30th day of June 1980, the Lorain City Planning Commission approved said vacation; and

WHEREAS, City Council, upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it ill not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.06 Ohio Revised Code, notice of the pendency and prayer of said petition is not required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That part of Idaho Avenue (60 feet wide) from the southline of "G" Street extending 135 feet south to the southline of W.B. Thompsons Tr's Addition in the City of Lorain, Ohio, be the same is hereby bacated, subject however to the reservation that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sanitary sewer conduits, storm sewer conduits, water conduits, gas and electric conduits, fire alarm system conduits, telephone and electric pole transmission lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said street whenever deemed necessary.

SECTION 2. That one-half (1/2) of the width of said street shall revert to the abutting owners on each side of said street.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
