AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE PETITION OF DALE YOST, AGENT FOR THE PETITIONERS KEITH M. OSKINS, DENISE A. OSKINS, AND HIGHLAND DEVELOPMENT CO., FOR ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF ELYRIA OF 0.403 ACRES OF LAND, SITUATED IN CARLISLE TOWNSHIP, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the petition of Dale Yost, Agent for Petitioners Keith M. Oskins, Denise A. Oskins, and Highland Development Co., which petition was approved by Lorain County County Commissioners under Resolution No. 94-649 and received by the Clerk of Council's Office on September 8, 1994, for the annexation to the City of Elyria of 0.403 acres of land, situated in Carlisle Township, being a part of Original Carlisle Township Section No. 5, and further described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein, being and the same is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: It is hereby determined by the Council of the City of Elyria that the territory described in Exhibit "A" be a part of Ward 3 of the City.

SECTION 3: That the Clerk of Council shall make three (3) copies containing the petition, the map or plat accompany Petition, a transcript of the proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners, and resolutions and ordinances in relation to annexation, with a certificate to each copy that is correct. The Auditor or Clerk forthwith deliver one such copy to the County Auditor and shall one such such copy to the County Recorder, who shall make a record thereof in the proper book of records and preserve it. The other copy shall be forwarded by the Auditor or Clerk to the Secretary of State.

SECTION 4: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
