AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1113.02 (B) (5), DEDICATION FOR PUBLIC USE, CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, AND REPEALING THE EXISTING SECTION 1113.02 (B) (5), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELYRIA, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That Section 1113.02 (b) (5), Dedication For Public Use, Codified Ordinances of the City of Elyria, be and the same is hereby amended and said Section 1113.02 (b) (5) shall now read as follows:

1113.02 (b) DEDICATION FOR PUBLIC USE

(5) If the final Plat indicates land for public use, the Plat shall be submitted to Council for acceptance of any public land, and acceptance for any easement before it is recorded. Such acceptance shall be noted upon the Plat and certified by the Clerk of City Council. The acceptance of any street or utility for public use and maintenance shall be by separate action of Council.

SECTION 2: The existing Section 1113.02 (b) (5), Codified Ordinances of the City of Elyria, be and the same hereby is repealed.

SECTION 3: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of Council concerning and relating to the adoption of the Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance be and hereby is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public, health, safety and welfare of the City; wherefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval.
