ORDINANCE NO. 95-81 AC CMS

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF STERN STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF OBERLIN, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 2, 1995, the City of Oberlin, Ohio, filed a subdivision plat for the Stern Street Subdivision in the City of Oberlin; and,

WHEREAS, said plat dedicated for public use a street designated as Stem Street in the City of Oberlin; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Oberlin desires to file an amended plat for said subdivision, and as a result of same, finds it in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Oberlin to vacate a portion of said Stern Street, in order to facilitate the possible sale of adjoining industrially zoned land and encourage economic development in the community; and,

WHEREAS, written consent to said proposed vacation from all abutting property owners has been previously filed with this Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Oberlin, County of Lorain, State of Ohio, five-sevenths (5/7th) of all members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1. That the portion of Stern Street as set forth in the legal description attached hereto, marked Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, be and hereby is vacated, and the City Manager is hereby directed to have prepared an amended plat of said subdivision showing said vacation, and the Clerk of Council is hereby instructed to endorse on such plat the action of this Council in vacating such portion of said street, and to cause said plat to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Lorain County, Ohio.

SECTION 2. The Clerk of Council is further directed to notify the Auditor of Lorain County, Ohio, of the vacation by sending him a certified copy of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning or relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Oberlin, Ohio, to wit:

"to authorize the vacation of a portion of a dedicated municipal roadway in order to allow immediate replatting and facilitate economic development"

and shall take effect immediately upon passage.


