Thence, northerly along the easterly right or way or Bond Street a distance of about 50' to point, said point being the south west corner of Sublot 116;

Thence, easterly in the northerly right of way line of Wilson Street a distance of about 226' to a point, said point being the southeast corner of Sublot 40;

Thence, southerly in the westerly right of way of Farr Avenue a distance of about 50' to the point of beginning;
