AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE ALLEY (16 feet wide) NORTH OF WEST 13TH STREET EXTENDING FROM THE WESTLINE OF REID AVENUE WESTERLY 500.00 FEET TO THE EASTLINE OF LEXINGTON AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a petition signed and submitted to Lorain City Council on May 23, 1983 and an ordinance adopted by Lorain City Council on June 6, 1983 represents 100% of the owners of property abutting that portion of the alley North of West 13th Street extending from the Westline of Reid Avenue westerly 500.00 feet to the Eastline of Lexington Avenue praying that said alley be vacated; and

WHEREAS, City Council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation as prayed for; that it will not be detrimental to the general interest and ought to be made; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Section 723.06, ORC notice of pendency and prayer of said petition is not required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LORAIN, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I.

That the alley (16 feet wide) north of West 13th Street extending from the westline of Reid Avenue westerly 500.00 feet to the eastline of Lexington Avenue, be the same is hereby vacated, subject however to the reservations that the City of Lorain, Ohio, reserves to itself and others, easement rights to construct or maintain sanitary sewer conduits, storm sewer conduits, water conduits, gas conduits, fire alarm system conduits, electric conduits, telephone and electric pole transmission lines and other similar facilities under, on or above said alley whenever deemed necessary.

SECTION II.

That each one-half of the alley will revert to the respective owners on each side of said alley.

SECTION III.

That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council conerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency, the nature of the emergency being as it is no longer needed for the purpose of a public alley and in order to provide adjacent real property owners with the exact dimensions of the real estate owned by the City of Iorain which abuts this alley in order to facilitate the sale of said property pursuant to Ordinance No. 76-83
