In reply to your request concerning the division of Fairlain Drive, which was vacated by the City of Amherst by Ordinance No. 0-82-49, according to the Ohio Revised Code, abutting owners are to have one half of the street.

The owners on tangent will have the lines at right angles to the property corners, and the owners on curves will have the radial to the property corners.

The calculated areas shown on the enclosed map are in square feet which can be converted to acreage to put on record with the Lorain County Auditor.

It is suggested that you contact the Lorain County Auditor and ask for his review before final disposition is made.

ordinance no. 0-82-49

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE FAIRLANE DRIVE A DEDICATED STREET WITHIN THE CITY AMHERST, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Amherst, Ohio has received a petition signed by the owners of certain property abutting upon Fairlane Drive, requesting that Fairlane Drive, a dedicated street, be vacated by the City Amherst, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, notice of such petition filed with the City of Amherst, Ohio, was published in accordance with Section 723.07, Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, public hearing regarding the vacation of Fairlane Drive was held pursuant to notice on the 27th day of September, 1982, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Amherst, Ohio finds that there is good cause for vacation of Fairlane Drive, and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest of the City of Amherst, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Amherst, Council Lorain, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Fairlane Drive, a dedicated street within the City of Amherst, County of Lorain, and State of Ohio extending between Butternut Dri and Edgewood Drive, as appears on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A, ar as more fully appears in the plat of Ridgeland Heights, Subdivision 3, as recorded in Volume 19, page 24 of the plat records of Lorain County, be, and hereby is vacated.

SECTION 2. That the Clerk of the Council of the City of Amherst, Ohio, be and hereby is, directed to notify the Lorain County Auditor and the Lorain County Treasurer of the vacation of the foregoing street, by sending them a copy of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and of any of its committ that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22, Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance whall be in full force and effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
